Since 1998, the Catholic Charities Dragon Boat Races have stormed the Inner Harbor for the biennial battle of the boats.

Each time, some of the area's most philanthropic businesses send their best paddlers for an 8-week long schedule of practices and fun, all for the chance to win the day and support Catholic Charities' 80 plus programs across Maryland. Funds raised by each team benefit the team's Catholic Charities partner program.

This is Catholic Charities' single largest fundraising event, helping improve thousands of lives across Maryland.

Practices & Race Day

Teams are comprised of 25 members (company employees, vendors, family, or friends.) There are 20 paddlers (minimum of 8 women), 1 drummer, and 1 steerer. The 3 other members rotate or serve as alternates.

Practices happen once a week for 8 weeks during a designated time slot under the supervision of our coaching staff.
